EDC Weekly Fees- per child

We have EARLY RELEASE on Wednesdays. School gets out at 2:00. If you pick up your child AFTER 2:15, they are in EXTENDED DAYCARE and you will be charged the weekly rate because we do not have a daily rate.

Morning EDC only \$20 (\$10 for each add'l child) Any time on campus, any day, before 7:45 a.m.

Afternoon EDC only \$40 (\$20 for each add'l child) Any time on campus any day, after 3:15 p.m.

Full EDC (a.m./p.m.) \$50 (\$25 for each add'l child) Any time on campus before 7:45 a.m. & after 3:15 p.m.

Full time during break weeks- \$95 a week or \$25 a day (this fee applies only to days that there are no regular K-8 classes and Extended Daycare is available).

We DO NOT have a daily rate for EDC. If your child stays for EDC any day of the week no matter what the reason or excuse is, even if only one day, you owe for the entire week.

<u>Late pick up</u> *\$3.00/minute Any minute past 5:30 p.m. (WE CLOSE AT 5:30)

*If you have more than THREE (3) late pick-ups during the school year, the 4th one and any others are \$5.00 per minute.

<u>Friday Clothing Fee</u> \$2.00 per Friday Guidelines for Friday clothing are in the <u>Uniform Policy</u>. This is a privilege and may be revoked as a consequence.

Illness Policy

Monday – Thursday Dress Code (*Friday dress code at bottom)

Tops for Females & Males- Uniform Polos with logos purchased at Pathways School.

*Bottoms for Females- Khaki or Navy Blue Shorts, Skirts, Skorts, Pants, Capris or Jumpers. All bottoms must be appropriate uniform bottoms. Leggings, jeggings, jeans and spandex are not allowed.

*Bottoms for Males- Khaki or Navy-Blue Shorts or Pants. No Cargo pockets or painter's pockets/loops allowed.

*Bottoms for males & females may be purchased at Walmart, Target, Old Navy, Amazon, etc.

Please make sure that they are UNIFORM bottoms. IF YOU ARE UNSURE, ASK!

ALL CLOTHING MUST FIT APPROPRIATELY. CLOTHING MAY NOT BE TOO LOOSE OR TOO TIGHT.

Girls & Boys- ALL BOTTOMS MUST BE WORN AT THE WAIST WITH A BELT.

<u>Girls & Boys</u>- The ONLY outerwear allowed to be worn inside the school is a Pathways Sweatshirt with School Logo or a solid black or solid navy blue (no stripes, words, patterns, etc. allowed). Outerwear must fit properly (not be too tight or too loose) and worn during cold weather only. <u>NO HOODIES ARE ALLOWED AT SCHOOL!!!</u>

Shoes- Sneakers or other shoes in any color. Sandals, flip flops, high heels, Crocs, slides, open toe shoes and backless shoes are NOT allowed.

Belts- Any color as long as there is nothing inappropriate on them.

Jewelry- Minimal jewelry allowed. No earrings for boys. No body piercings. No temporary tattoos. No heavy chains allowed. No faux body piercings.

Hair- Hair must be neat, clean and well-groomed. No bizarre styles or colors (NO pink, orange, white, silver, blue, green, purple or any shade of these). Hair may not hang in the face. No Mohawks or shaved hair designs (lines are allowed). Hairstyles may not be extreme or distracting. Hair may not hang in the face.

Headwear- No caps, hats, bandanas, or scarves may be worn. Headbands are allowed.

Undershirts- Any shirt, tank or tee worn under the uniform must be **solid white**, **solid navy blue or solid black** and must fit appropriately.

Shirts must be tucked in at all times while on campus. All shorts and pants must be worn at the waist with a belt through the belt loops. NO chains attached to clothing or backpacks allowed.

Friday Only Dress Code (students may choose to wear the M-Th uniform)

Students who pay \$2.00 on Friday may wear their own APPROPRIATE clothing. The \$2.00 is due before class starts on Friday morning. If a student wears their own clothes and doesn't pay the \$2.00 before class begins, they will lose the privilege of wearing their own clothes for the next 2 weeks.

<u>The following items are NOT allowed</u>: NO sleeveless_tops or shirts, cut-off jeans (cut out or ripped parts may be at the knee or below, NOT above the knee on the front or back of the leg unless wearing tights, etc. under), pants or shorts that are sagging, tops with any offensive words, graphics or pictures on them, chains attached to clothing, sheer or see-thru clothing, no sundresses or spaghetti straps, no tube tops, and nothing that shows shoulders or stomach. Shorts, dresses and skirts must be no higher than 6 inches above the knee. Leggings and jeggings may only be worn under skirts and dresses or with a top that completely covers the backside. Clothing must be clean, in good shape and fit properly. Closed toe shoes only. **No sandals, slides, Crocs or flip flops.**

Pathways Discipline Policy

Classroom management is left to each individual teacher. Teachers are expected to handle discipline in their classrooms on a daily basis. Teachers will be responsible for contacting parents by telephone or in writing to inform them of any discipline problems in the classroom. Teachers will choose a consequence for breaking rules that may include, but not be limited to, detention, missed PE/recess, missed Enrichment, missed Friday dress-down privilege or loss of other school activities/privileges and/or writing a summary of the offense and the consequence.

When a student receives their 4th referral, they will be given a suspension. A student is expelled when they receive their 4th suspension.

If a pattern of misbehavior develops, and classroom instruction is disrupted, the teacher will notify a member of the administrative staff to assess the need for a parent conference involving the classroom teacher, the parents, the student, and administration. The administrative staff will determine the need for further action which may include, but not be limited to, suspension or expulsion from school. The administrative staff will assess specific behavior on an individual basis. Behaviors that may warrant immediate suspension/expulsion may include, but not be limited to, insubordination, acts of violence, overt disrespect, threats, bullying, leaving school property without permission and other unsafe behavior.

We are here to teach the students math, science, reading, and history; but we are also here to teach them life skills. Our goal is to help students become productive members of society. It is imperative they learn respect for authority, responsibility, accountability for their actions, and the importance of following rules in order for us to provide a safe learning environment for every student at Pathways School.

Hours of Operation- Pathways School hours of operation are 6:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.
Parents will be charged a late fee for children not picked up by 5:30 p.m. The late fee must be
paid by the following day. Class hours are 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. <u>EARLY RELEASE DAY IS</u>
WEDNESDAY and students in K-8 are released at 2:00.
Registration - The full registration fee is due at time of registration. <i>The registration fee</i>
is non-refundable. Copies of the following items are necessary to complete your child's folder:
birth certificate, parent/guardian driver's license, child's insurance card, current physical and
shot records and 4-C paperwork when applicable. Your child will not be allowed to
start school with an incomplete registration folder.
Curriculum Fee- This fee covers the curriculum and resources that are used during the
year. <mark>The</mark> Curriculum Fee is non-refundable.
Tuition - Tuition covers the academic year, 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., Mon/Tues/Thurs/Fri
and 8:00 – 2:00 on Wednesday. Tuition is paid in 10 payments. The first one is due in August
and the last one in May. The monthly tuition is ONLY paid by DIRECT DEBIT. A
late fee of \$25.00 is due for any NSF on the Direct Debit. Days missed for illness,
holidays, personal reasons, vacations, suspensions, etc. are not deductible. Refunds will not be
made.
Parent/Guardian Conduct- Rude and obnoxious behavior from parents/guardians on
school campus will not be tolerated We have a ZERO TOLERANCE Policy for any threats or
violence against our staff, students, family members of students/staff or Pathways School
property. Any such behavior will result in the family being asked to leave our school and the
obligation agreement will be in effect. Please remember that we are a place of business where
children are always present. We ask that you are fully clothed while on school property and
that your clothing has no inappropriate language or graphics. Smoking is strictly prohibited on
school property. NO CELL PHONE USE ALLOWED INSIDE PATHWAYS SCHOOL- please do not
take or make phone calls inside our school.

EDC-Extended Daycare- Students may not be on campus before 7:45 a.m. or after 3:15
p.m. (or 2:15 on Wednesday), unless they are in our Extended Daycare program for an
additional fee. EDC is charged weekly <mark>. If your child is in attendance any day of the week</mark>
(before or after care), you will be charged the weekly fee. There is NO DAILY EDC FEE.
Extended Daycare is an extension of the school day and the rules, regulations and standards of conduct apply. Students may participate in Homework Room, receive tutoring, and enjoy social time with their friends.
Returned Checks- Parents will be charged a fee of \$25.00 for each returned check. Repeat offenders will be required to pay with cash, credit card or money order only.
Repeat offenders will be required to pay with easily creat eard of money order only.
Absences and Tardiness- It is the parent's responsibility to see that their child is at school on time every day. Any student arriving after 8:01 a.m. will be marked tardy. Absences and tardiness reflect on the student's report card and permanent cumulative file.
School Uniform- All students, K – 8th, must be in a clean, neat and complete uniform every day. Students not dressed in proper uniform may not attend class. Uniform Bottoms may be purchased at Walmart and Target, etc. Uniform Polos, Uniform Sweatshirts, and Pathways' T-shirts may be purchased at Pathways School. NO HOODIES ALLOWED AT SCHOOL.
Conferences- Conferences with the classroom teacher or the Principal may be scheduled by calling the front office or sending a note with your child. DO NOT try to meet with the teacher at drop-off or pick-up time. At these times, teachers are responsible for their students and cannot meet with parents.
Visitor Policy - All parents are considered visitors and must check in at the front office. All classroom visits must be scheduled with the classroom teacher and Principal prior to the visit.
Drop off and Pick up- Car doors will be opened by patrols every morning between 7:45 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., and students will be escorted to cars every afternoon between 3:00 p.m. and 3:15 p.m. If you need to come inside for or with your child, please park in a designated parking space. Per the State Fire Marshall, cars cannot be left unattended in the pick-up/drop-off circle. PLEASE be courteous, kind, and exercise caution and patience while in the parking lot. Pathways Withdrawal Policy for K – 8 Students

This signed and notarized policy is in effect throughout the duration of your student's enrollment at Pathways School.

PLEASE READ THIS POLICY AND MAKE SURE THAT YOU UNDERSTAND IT.

If you choose to withdraw and leave Pathways School, you must submit a letter in writing that GIVES YOUR 30 DAY NOTICE AND YOU MUST STAY UNTIL 30 DAYS FROM THE DAY YOU SUBMIT THE LETTER TO THE OFFICE.

If you do not give written notice and stay the 30 days OR you leave before your 30 days is up OR your child is expelled, you owe an OBLIGATION AGREEMENT.

Your OBLIGATION AGREEMENT is the remainder of the tuition for the entire school year. Tuition is \$8,000. If you leave without staying the 30 days, you owe 8,000 minus the amount you have paid FOR TUITION or a scholarship has paid for tuition. You must pay this if you do not follow the guidelines for withdrawing and attending for the school days in the 30 days after you turn in your letter of withdrawal.

The obligation fee must be paid in full and you must have a zero balance on your account for any records to be transferred.

I understand that if I withdraw my child or leave for any reason, including expulsion, I must give a 30 day notice in writing and attend all school days within the 30 days or I will have to pay the Obligation Agreement.

Pathways School reserves the right at its sole discretion to make the decision to terminate a student's enrollment for repeated discipline policy violations or violations of the Parent Code of Conduct.
