Pathways Discipline Policy

Classroom management is left to each individual teacher. Teachers are expected to handle discipline in their classrooms daily. Teachers will be responsible for contacting parents by telephone or in writing to inform them of any discipline problems in the classroom. Teachers will choose a consequence for breaking rules that may include, but not be limited to, detention, loss of school activities/privileges and/or writing a summary of the offense and the consequence.

When a student receives their 4th referral, they will be given a suspension. A student is expelled when they receive their 4th suspension.

These actions will result in an automatic suspension: fighting (or any other actions deemed dangerous), phone use when not authorized, putting a password on a school device, and downloading anything on a school device without permission. The first time a student uses inappropriate, racist, or vulgar language, a referral will be issued. If there is a 2nd time, the student will be suspended.

If a pattern of misbehavior develops, and classroom instruction is disrupted, the teacher will notify a member of the administrative staff to assess the need for a parent conference involving the classroom teacher, the parents, the student, and administration. The administrative staff will determine the need for further action which may include, but not be limited to, suspension or expulsion from school. The administrative staff will assess specific behavior on an individual basis. Behaviors that may warrant immediate suspension/expulsion may include, but not be limited to, insubordination, acts of violence, overt disrespect, threats, bullying, leaving school property without permission and other unsafe behavior.

We are here to teach the students math, science, reading, and history; but we are also here to teach them life skills. Our goal is to help students become productive members of society. It is imperative they learn respect for authority, responsibility, accountability for their actions, and the importance of following rules in order for us to provide a safe learning environment for every student at Pathways Private School.

Pathways Graduation and Attendance Policies

Florida State Compulsory Attendance Laws require students to attend a minimum of **180 actual school days or the hourly equivalent (900 hours)**. Students missing more than 4 days in a grading period will be considered truant and a conference with the teacher, Principal and parent/s will be held. A Doctor's excuse or note from the parent should accompany the student upon returning to school after an absence. Students are NOT allowed to work from home instead of coming to school.

Pathways Grade Changes, Incomplete Grades, and Course Recovery

Grade Change Policy

Grades submitted by teachers at the end of the term are final and are not subject to change on the basis of revision of judgement such as a new exam or additional work completed after the original grade has been submitted. The Teacher will consult with the Principal before any grade changes are made and will be approved ONLY if one of the following reasons has occurred:

1. Correction of error in grading, or entering a grade wrong
2. Submitting a final grade for an "I" grade (see Incomplete Grade Policy below)

Any correction of a grade must take place within one year of the start date of the course in which the grade was assigned.

Incomplete Grades Policy

An Incomplete "I" is a temporary grade which may be given at the Teacher's discretion to a student for the purpose of unit/missed work recovery (Semester Recovery, SR).

The following provisions for Incomplete grades apply:

- Specific understanding/contract with completion date between student and teacher of what is expected to successfully pass a class
- Before the end of the term, the student and Teacher complete the incomplete Grade form.
- The student has one term to demonstrate mastery and earn the credit before the grade turns into an "F"
- "I"s must be updated within one year of the start date of the course in which the grade was assigned

Course/Credit Recovery Policy

Students who have earned a failing grade in a core course may be approved to earn credit through the Credit Recovery program. Permission must be obtained from the Principal and Teacher in order for a student to repeat a course. Students may repeat up to 3 courses for course recovery.

High School Dress Code

Tops- Dress Code T-shirt that is sold in the Front Office. Shirts may not be tied up in any way at the waist.

Outerwear- **Jackets, sweaters, sweatshirts, and shirts worn over the Pathways T-Shirt may ONLY be solid gray, solid black or solid blue. No designs, words, numbers, graphics, colors or patches allowed on outerwear.**

Bottoms- Any jeans, pants, capris, shorts, or skirts that fit properly and cannot be too large or too tight or sag off the backside. **Bottoms must be worn at the waist.** Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than 6 inches above the middle of the kneecap. **Jeans or pants may not have rips or holes in them above the knee.** *If jeans/pants/bottoms have holes, rips, shreds or tears above the knees, something must be worn underneath the jeans to cover the skin.* No pajamas. No sweatpants. No yoga pants. No pants, joggers, shorts, etc. made from flannel, or sweatpant fabric. Students must look neat.

Shoes- Any sneakers, loafers, or low heel boots and shoes are allowed. Shoes may not be open toe or open back. **Sandals, slides and flip flops are not allowed.** Crocs may be worn.

Jewelry- Minimal jewelry allowed.

We do not allow any inappropriate words or pictures to show/be worn on clothing, jewelry or tattoos.

Food & Snack Policy and Extended Time on Campus Policies

Food & Snacks

Pathways offers a Free Breakfast, Free Lunch and Snacks daily for all students. **Students do not have access to microwaves or refrigerators.** Students are NOT ALLOWED to have food or snacks delivered by any food service or anybody bringing outside food. Students may use the vending machines on campus for meals and snacks. Students will be allowed to leave campus on Fridays, for 45 minutes, to eat lunch nearby and then return to school.

Extended Time on Campus

Class hours for High School are 8:00 – 1:30, Monday – Friday. Students are only allowed to stay after school (later than 1:30) if they are on a sports team and there is practice, a game or activity **OR** if the student waits for a sibling in K-8 that gets out and leaves at 3:00 (or 2:00 on Wednesdays).

_____ **Hours-** Pathways hours of operation are 6:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Parents will be charged a late fee for any student not picked up by 5:30 p.m. The late fee must be paid by the following day. Class hours are 8:00 a.m. – 1:30 p.m., Monday – Friday.

_____ **Registration-** The full registration fee is due at time of registration. *The registration fee is non-refundable.* Copies of the following items are necessary to complete your child's folder: **birth certificate, parent/guardian driver's license, student's insurance card, current physical and shot records.** Your student will not be allowed to start school with an incomplete registration folder.

_____ **Curriculum Fee-** This fee covers the curriculum and resources that are used during the year. *The Curriculum Fee is non-refundable.*

_____ **Tuition-** Tuition covers the academic year for class hours. Tuition is paid in 10 payments. The first one is due in August and the last one in May. Days missed for illness, holidays, personal reasons, vacations, suspensions, etc. are not deductible. Refunds will not be made.

_____ **Parent/Guardian Conduct-** Rude and obnoxious behavior from parents/guardians on school campus will not be tolerated. **We have a ZERO TOLERANCE Policy for any threats or violence against our staff, students, family members of students/staff or Pathways School property.** Any such behavior will result in the family being asked to leave our school and the obligation agreement will be in effect. Please remember that we are a place of business where students are always present. We ask that you are fully clothed while on school property and that your clothing has no inappropriate language or graphics. Smoking is strictly prohibited on school property. **NO CELL PHONE USE IS ALLOWED INSIDE PATHWAYS SCHOOL-** please do not take or make phone calls inside our school.

_____ **Returned Checks-** Parents will be charged a fee of \$25.00 for each returned check. Repeat offenders will be required to pay with cash, credit card or money order only.

_____ **Absences and Tardiness-** It is the parent's responsibility to see that their student is at school on time every day. Any student arriving after 8:01 a.m. will be marked tardy. Absences and tardiness reflect on the student's report card and permanent cumulative file.

_____ **School Uniform-** All students, 9-12, must be clean, neat, and complete uniform every day. Students not dressed in proper uniform may not attend class. Shirts may only be purchased in the school office.

_____ **Conferences-** Conferences with the classroom teacher or the Principal may be scheduled by calling the front office or sending a note with your child. **DO NOT** try to meet with the teacher at drop-off or pick-up time. At these times, teachers are responsible for their students and cannot meet with parents.

_____ **Visitor Policy-** All parents are considered visitors and must check in at the front office. All classroom visits must be scheduled with the classroom teacher and Principal prior to the visit.

_____ **Drop off and pick up-** If you need to come inside for or with your student, please park in a designated parking space. Per the State Fire Marshall, cars cannot be left unattended in the pick-up/drop-off circle. PLEASE be courteous, kind, and exercise caution and patience while in the parking lot. Let's keep our students safe!

_____ **Student Pick-Up During School Hours-** No student is permitted to leave the school during school hours unless he/she is signed out through the school office by a parent/guardian. The exception is Friday lunch. The parent/guardian must come in and sign the student out for the day. Students who are 18 or older are allowed to sign themselves out of school.

_____ **Overdue Account Balances-** A zero balance is always required on accounts. School records, including report cards, will be held for accounts with overdue balances. Students with overdue account balances will not be able to participate in the end of the year activities. Past due accounts must be paid with cash or a money order for records to be released.

_____ **Damage-** Campus property, textbooks/curriculum or personal property destroyed, damaged, or lost by any student will be replaced or repaired immediately at the parent/guardian's expense.

_____ **Student Withdrawal/Obligation Agreement-** Our school is staffed based on the number of students enrolled. If a child is withdrawn for any reason (including expulsion), without at least 30 days written notice, there is an Obligation fee that is owed, and any additional fees are required before student records will be transferred. Payment must be made with cash, money order, or credit card. Files of students who leave owing money will be sent to our Collections Department, where additional fees will be assessed. Please refer to the PATHWAYS SCHOOL WITHDRAWAL POLICY FOR 9-12 STUDENTS for the amount you are obligated to pay if you withdraw your student(s) during the school year.

_____ **Miscellaneous-** GUM IS NEVER ALLOWED ON CAMPUS! All 9-12 students are dismissed from campus at 1:30 daily and must leave unless they are waiting on a younger sibling to be dismissed from class or they are involved in a sports or school-related activity that requires them to stay beyond dismissal.

_____ **Policy Violation Disclaimer-** Pathways reserves the right at its sole discretion to make the decision to terminate a student's enrollment for repeated discipline policy violations or violations of the Parent Code of Conduct, Student Code of Conduct, behavior issues, attendance issues or failure to maintain a zero balance on your account.

_____ **State Regulations-** As mandated by State Law, a current physical, immunization record and birth certificate must be on file at Pathways School within 30 days of the child's first day of school.

The obligation fee must be paid in full, and you must have a zero balance on your account for any records to be transferred.
